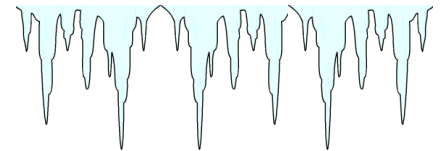
Giving Tree
